The challenge

- Achieving consistent endoscopic image analysis, which can be affected by reader score subjectivity and variable image quality from sites
- Ensuring a coordinated approach between eCOA and imaging data collection strategies, which recognizes interdependencies

Situation

A European sponsor was performing a three-year ulcerative colitis study with over 300 participants.

This study took place in sites across North and South America, Europe and APAC.
